SECTION 1: LEGISLATIVE
TRAFFIC BYLAW No. 09-2015
APPENDIX A: ENFORCEMENT PENALTIES

Any person who contravenes the Traffic Bylaw may be subject to a Provincial Violation Ticket or a Municipal Ticket.

Any person who is issued a Municipal Ticket shall be subject to a penalty as listed in this Bylaw.

Any person who is issued a Provincial Violation Ticket shall be subject to a penalty as listed in the Alberta Traffic Safety Act or associated regulations including, but not limited to, the Provincial Offences Procedure Act, (Alberta), Vehicle Equipment Regulation (AR 122/2009) the Use of Highway and Rules of the Road Regulation (AR 304/2002), Commercial Vehicle Dimension and Weight Regulation (AR 315/2002), Commercial Vehicle Safety Regulation (AR 121/2009) and amendments thereof

Every person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable to summary conviction to a penalty as prescribed in this bylaw. A notice or form commonly called an Offence Ticket, may be issued by a Peace Officer to any person alleged to have breached any provision of this bylaw, and the amount specified in this bylaw

An Offence Ticket shall be deemed to be sufficiently served:

If served personally on the accused; or

If mailed to the address of the registered owner of the property concerned, or the vehicle concerned or to the person concerned;

Except as otherwise provided in this bylaw, a person who is guilty of an offence under this bylaw for which a penalty is not otherwise provided, is liable to a fine of not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and in default of payment, is liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six (6) months without the option of a fine.

701	Rules for Operation	As per the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and associated regulations
801	General Provisions	\$50
802, 803	Weights	As per the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and associated regulations
804-807	Cleaning and Clearing	\$50
901, 902	Truck routes, explosives	\$100 or as per the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and associated regulations
1001	Off Highway Vehicles	\$270 or as per the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and associated regulations
1002	Off Highway Vehicles	\$270 or as per the Alberta Traffic Safety Act and associated regulations

If any provision herein is found to be invalid for any reason then that provision shall be severed from the remainder of this Bylaw and all other provisions of this Bylaw shall remain valid and enforceable.

This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof.
