

BY-LAW NO. 10-95

OF THE

VILLAGE OF WABAMUN

IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF WABAMUN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO ESTABLISH A DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS Section 624 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1995 requires each Municipality to provide for a Development Authority;

AND WHEREAS Section 624 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1995 allows each Municipality to delegate the authority to exercise development powers and duties to a designated officer;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Wabamun in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

THAT - the administration of the development approval process be delegated to the Administrator of the Village of Wabamun;

THAT - the adoption of this Bylaw is effective upon the date of the passing of third and final reading of this Bylaw.

READ A FIRST TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 18 DAY OF September A.D. 1995.

READ A SECOND TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 18 DAY OF September, A.D. 1995.

READ A THIRD TIME IN COUNCIL AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 18 DAY OF September, A.D. 1995.
